BEST APPS FOR 2020

Start the new year off right and check out some of the best apps for your smartphone. A few of these apps have been around for a while, but they keep updating them and making them better.

Google Pay allows you to add many different card types as well as reward cards. Google Pay uses a virtual card number that is different from the actual card number to keep your information safe. If you have a Samsung phone, Samsung Pay is a great option also.

Google Find My Device comes in handy in the case of theft or loss of your device. You can access it from a laptop or desktop, so you don't need your phone to find your phone! You can also lock a phone or erase any data remotely if it's been stolen.

For students, CamScanner is a valuable app to use to your phone's camera to scan documents. You can auto-crop scanned photos and save results to the system in PDF/JPEG format and add notes or tags to any document. TickTick is a to-do list app that covers the basics like recurring tasks, reminders, push notifications, various organizational features, and categories, all while letting you share tasks and categories with other people.

Google Maps recently updated and has a new tab called "For You." This new feature acts like a newsfeed which presents you with recommended places to go and allows you to follow certain locations.

Upcoming updates to Google Maps include music streaming and assistant integration and Google Lens and Street View. Adding Google Lens allows you to identify various street signs and landmarks, which would then be linked to Maps and Street View.

This is a great opportunity to say goodbye to some of the old Android apps that you don't really use anymore and enjoy the ones that are most useful.


NATIONAL DO-NOT-CALL REGISTRY

The federal government created the National Do-Not-Call Registry to make it easier and more efficient for you to stop getting most telemarketing sales calls you don't want. You can register online at www.donotcall.gov, if you have an active email address; or you can call toll free 1-888-382-1222 (TTY 1-866-290-4236) from the number you wish to register.

Registration is free and will not expire. Your phone number, when

placed on the Do-Not-Call Registry, will remain there permanently. If you would like to remove your number from this list, you must call 1-888-382-1222 from the number you wish to delete. If you receive telemarketing calls after you have registered your telephone number and it has been on the registry for three months, you can file a complaint at www.donotcall.gov or by calling 1-888-382-1222 (TTY 1-866-290-4236). You will have to know the company's name or phone number to file a "do-not-call" complaint.
