# Texting Tips

Whether you fancy yourself an expert or are constantly googling ways to be more efficient when it comes to your cell phone and text messaging, the below tips may be a good reminder or new information.

## Schedule a text

Sometimes you don't want to send a message immediately, but it's easy to completely forget to respond. Here's how to schedule a text to send at a later time:

Select your contact.

Tap the + symbol.

Tap schedule message and chose date and time.

Tap Done and the message will look gray and have a clock beside it.

## Mark important messages

Some messages are too important to lose, but you can "star" a message for easy reference.

Tap and hold on to the message you wish to star.

Tap the star message button in the pop up menu.

To see your starred messages, return to the Messages home screen.

Tap the three-button menu on the left and tap Starred Messages.

## Send your location in a text

If someone needs to know how to find you or where to pick you up, you can text them your location. Here's how to use the feature within a text message:

Tap the + symbol.

Select the location button in the menu.

Tap Done once the map appears with your location.

Tap the send button.

A Google image and a link will be sent with the option to get directions.

## Add to your calendar

Have you noticed when someone sends you a date and time it's underlined? That's because you can add it to your calendar. Just follow these steps.

Click on the text with the date.

It will open a calendar event you can title and edit however you like.

Save and away you go!


