

Keeping Your Home Wi-Fi Network Secure

Change your passwords

Not only change your password to something stronger, but use a password manager. This will ensure it's more random and stores it so you don't forget it.

Update your router

Wi-Fi technology has improved a lot recently, so if your router is a few years old, it won't work nearly as well as a new one. Newer Wi-Fi technology uses stronger wireless signals and allows multiple users to connect at the same time.

Check for outdated client devices

While your Wi-Fi router is an important part of the Wi-Fi network, the wireless devices that you use to connect to the Internet also impact the quality of your Wi-Fi experience. As with the router, older devices are going to have outdated technology, resulting in slower connection speeds.

Set up a guest network for smart home devices

A guest network is a feature on some routers where you can set up a separate SSID and password for access to your home network, and people on that network won't be able to see devices (and their traffic) on your primary network.
