National Do-Not-Call Registry

The federal government created the National Do-Not-Call Registry to make it easier and more efficient for you to stop getting most telemarketing sales calls you don't want. You can register online at www.donotcall.gov, if you have an active email address; or you can call toll-free 1-888-382-1222 (TTY 1-866-290-4236) from the number you wish to register.

Registration is free and will not expire. Your phone number, when placed on the Do-Not-Call Registry, will remain there permanently. If you would like

to remove your number from this list, you must call 1-888-382-1222 from the number you wish to delete.

If you receive telemarketing calls after you have registered your telephone number and it has been on the registry for 31 days, you can file a complaint at www.donotcall.gov or by calling 1-888-382-1222 (TTY 1-866-290-4236). You will have to know the company's name or phone number to file a "donot-call" complaint.

Relay South Dakota

Relay SD is a service that provides telephone access for people with speech or hearing loss who find it challenging to use a traditional telephone. Relay SD makes it possible for deaf, hard-of-hearing or speech-disabled people to communicate over the phone.

Relay SD offers amplified and captioned phones for those who have trouble hearing details of phone conversations.

They also offer other solutions such as Text Telephone (TTY), Voice Carry-Over (VCO), and Hearing Carry-Over (HCO). Spanish Relay and Internet-Based Relay services are also available.
