There are many options when it comes to streaming which means switching from traditional TV doesn't mean you have to give up your favorite channels. There are good reasons why four out of every five homes in the U.S. are now subscribing to at least one streaming service. Many Gen Z and Millennials aren't even buying TVs anymore. In a 2023 Consumer

Technology Association study, 68% of consumers in this age group own a TV versus 87% of total US adults.

Things are changing, and it can be confusing to keep up! The presentation will cover what streaming is and why so many people have cut the cord, what streaming services are, and how to choose what's best for you.
